Empowering Minority Women Business Owners and Strengthening Their Skill Sets To Elevate Their Potential and Thrive as Successful Entrepreneurs

DALLAS, TX – March 9, 2022 – Building on the success of 2021's inaugural Women of Color: Shaping The Future Conference, and to continue empowering and supporting minority women business owners, LiftFund <u>Dallas/Ft.</u> Worth Women's Business Center is pleased to announce the one-day conference's return on March 24.

This one-day conference hosted on the campus of Southern Methodist University's COX School of Business, will inspire and provide useful tools for minority business women to thrive as successful leaders and innovators and will ultimately help close the inequalities gap.

The 2022 opening keynote speaker is Cate Luzio the founder and CEO of Luminary, a membership-based career and personal growth platform created to uplift women and help them acquire the skills they need for all phases of their professional journeys.

Before launching Luminary, Luzio worked for 20 years in financial services leading global multibillion-dollar businesses, including her role as Global Head of Multinational Corporate Banking for HSBC. She was most recently recognized as one of Forbes magazine's Next 1000 Entrepreneurs and a Top 100 Female Founder in Inc.

"In the U.S., more than 11.6 million businesses are owned by women, nearly half of those businesses are majority owned by women of color," says Tarsha Polk Hearns, director of LiftFund Dallas/Ft. Worth Women's Business Center. "Our purpose at the Women's Business Center is to provide a safe space and be a reliable resource for female entrepreneurs so that we can dramatically scale that statistic in the near future."

<u>Registration</u> for the Women of Color: Shaping the Future Conference is currently open and costs \$45 to attend. Participants will learn from and engage with some of the most prominent minority business owners and entrepreneurs in their local communities and be presented with useful resources and skill building opportunities.
